Poster FAQs

What topics are you accepting for the poster presentations?

Topics should include new and innovative approaches to clinical care, workflows or processes in the emergency department. Examples may include management of boarding, use of artificial intelligence, telemedicine, etc. You may also submit interesting case presentations.

What is the format for the poster?

Clinical research and process improvement posters should follow the format of a traditional scientific abstract including:

- Title
- Authors
- Disclosures
- Objectives
- Methods
- Results
- Limitations
- Conclusions

Interesting case presentations should follow the below format:

- Chief complaint
- History of present illness
- Physical exam, patient images
- Laboratory and imaging results
- Case discussion with three bulleted take home points or pearls

What size poster is needed?

36" high by 48" wide

How much time will I have to present?

Poster presentations will occur in the morning with attendees rotating to each poster. Plan for a 3 -5 min presentation followed by time for questions.
